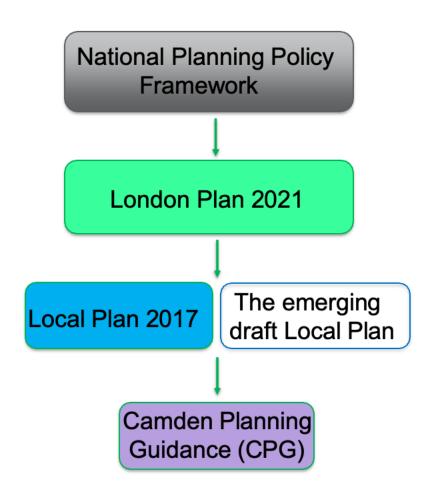
Proposal

- Demolition of all buildings and structures on site
- Site A:
 - Three new buildings of 10, 10 and 15 storeys
 - 119 homes (all social rent)
 - Approx. 2,100sqm of affordable studio and workshop space
- Site B:
 - Three new buildings of 10, 13 and 31 storeys
 - 282 homes (203 private sale and 79 intermediate rent)
 - Approx. 28,600sqm of life science, light industrial and commercial space
- Public realm and landscaping improvements provided across both sites

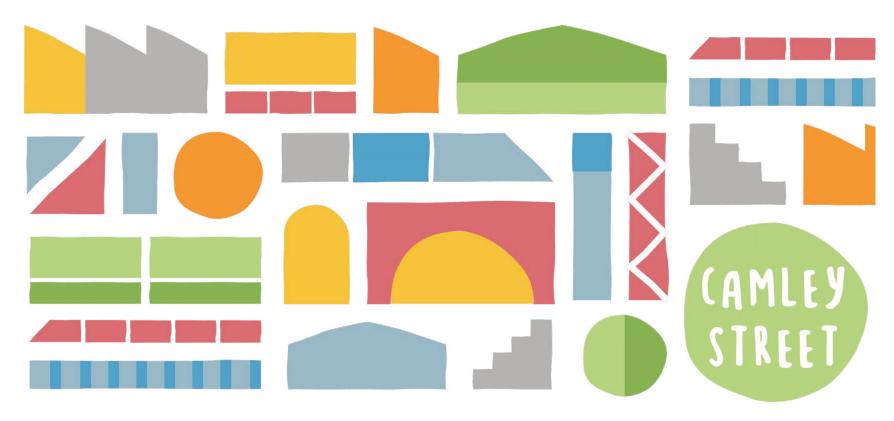




Main Planning Considerations

- Community benefits (employment and training measures, community space management, public realm improvements, long-term engagement)





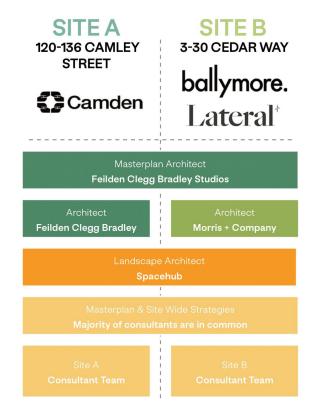

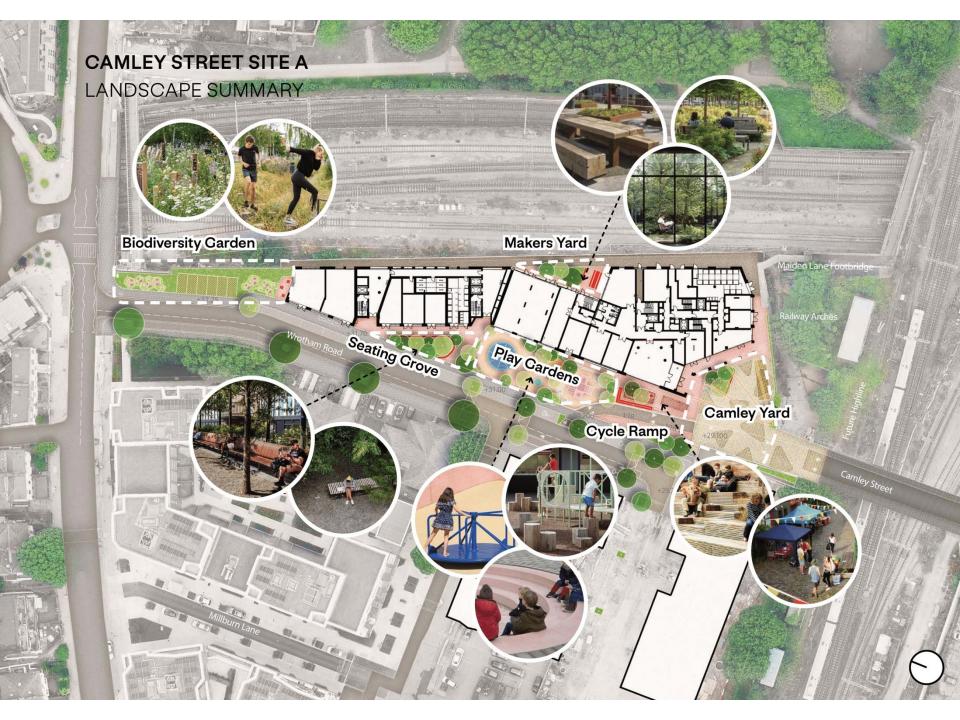

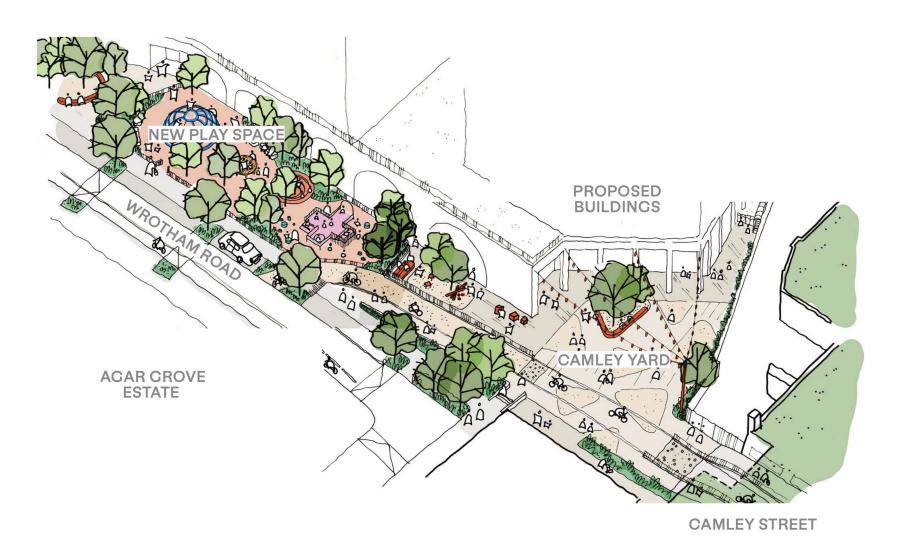
