The glazing in a frame had been removed and the wood stripped to assess the quality of the wood. Some wood had been spliced and some had been resin-filled. The glass was on order and should arrive in a few weeks. On arrival it will be fitted immediately.

2 The concept of trickle vents and their functioning were explained. The need for ventilation was explored thoroughly. It was noted that condensation would accrue in unventilated hones leading to black mould. The vents would allow air in, and extractor fans would remove it. Questions were asked about the trickle ventilator size and extractor fan and where they could be located. The vents need to be installed at a high level and the fan will automatically switch on when a sensor in the trickle vent detects a high moisture level. Jason confirmed that he will be led by experts and ever mindful of heritage matters, with the intention of finding a solution that works for everyone. Nick confirmed that he is guided by the architects and if residents can identify a scheme that may work better, he will look at it.

3 The Pilot Scheme will be followed by a conditions survey, which will be reported to elected members prior to work proceeding.

4 The project team will continue to report to members of the RLG, both through regular meetings and via the website.

5 As agreed previously, future meeting of the RLG will be bi-monthly, with the RLG for the rest of the estate occurring in the intervening months. The next meeting of the Crescent House RLG will be from 6.00 pm to 7.00 pm on Thursday 27 July 2023 in the Community Centre.
