





Previous planning permission

In 2019 planning permission was granted for a 3-screen cinema.

Unfortunately, before the work could commence the COVID-19 pandemic began, which caused a downturn in entertainment and hospitality industry.



Previous planning permission

Following the consent structural surveys were undertaken that revealed the poor state of the building.

As a result the previously scheme is no longer viable.







The condition of the existing building requires a demolition and complete rebuild, to include:

- Rebuilding of the iconic 'Art Deco' front Façade facing onto Beach Street
- A new cinema containing 49 seats
- Nine new townhouses and three apartments
- A café for public use, with an outdoor seating area
- Improvements to the public square and improved local connectivity



The façade

The iconic 'Art Deco' front Façade facing onto Beach Street will be need to be demolished due to structural reasons.


This will be rebuilt to appear as it does today and will keep the iconic and much-loved vista onto Beach Street.



Proposed cinema


49 comfortable seats.
