The Squirrels Project Nears Completion

It has been a busy few months at The Squirrels, and the project to deliver new short break respite accommodation for adults with learning disabilities and autistic people, who have eligible social care needs, is now entering its final stages. The team is completing the remaining finishing works, final inspections and snagging to make sure every area meets the required standards ahead of handover.

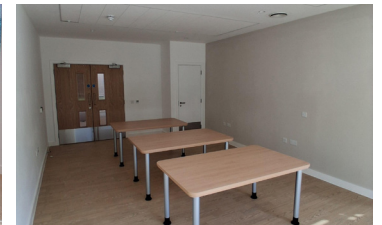
The project has experienced some challenging weather conditions, from an exceptionally wet winter through to periods of extreme heat during the summer. Despite this, the site team and our supply chain partners have continued to make strong progress, adapting activities where needed and working together to keep the project moving forward.

Attention is now focused on the final details, including testing and commissioning of the building services, completing external works, resolving any outstanding snags and preparing the building for its final inspections.

The team is also collating the handover information and operational documents required to support the building once it is in use.

We would like to thank our local neighbours for their patience and understanding throughout the works. We appreciate the support shown during the construction period and look forward to sharing the completed project very soon.
